

ORDINANCE NO. 164

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF ELEVENTH STREET AND A PORTION OF SEVENTH AVENUE IN SOUTH CREEDE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE CITY OF CREEDE, A TOWN, IN THE STATE OF COLORADO:

Section 1. That the portion of Eleventh Street west of San Luis Avenue and east of the railroad right-of-way as now located in that part of the City of Creede platted and known as South Creede be, and the same hereby is vacated and closed, and shall no longer be deemed a part of said street.

Section 2. The South Thirty feet of that part of Seventh Avenue west of Colorado Highway 149 and immediately north of the Snowshoe Lodge, as now located, in that part of the City of Creede platted and known as South Creede be, and the same hereby is, vacated and closed and shall no longer be deemed a part of said Avenue.

Section 3. The Board of Trustees of the City of Creede, Colorado, hereby finds, determines and certifies that said tracts of land, are not and have not been a portion of any water works, ditch, grass works, electric light works, or other public utility or public building, and are not and have not been used or held for part purposes or any other governmental purposes, nor are the same required for any such purposes.
