

An Ordinance concerning
and vacating Avenues,
Streets and Alleys in a por-
tion of that part of the City
of Creede platted and known
as Creedmoor, formerly
Amethyst.

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE
BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF
THE CITY OF CREEDE, A
TOWN:**

Section 1. Whereas, that por-
tion of the City of Creede, here-
inafter referred to and described
was platted and laid out in the
year 1892, when modes of trans-
portation were by means of
horsedrawn carts, heavy wagons
and other means no longer used;

And, Whereas, the streets, av-
enues, alleys and passageways in
said area are largely not adapted
to modern means of transporta-
tion, and the present owner or
the lots and lands served by such
streets, avenues, alleys and pas-
sageways desires to relocate such
public ways so as to eliminate
steep grades and dangerous corn-
ers, and decrease traffic hazards
and make said properties more
easily accessible, and the Board
of Trustees of said Town has
found and hereby finds, deter-
mines and declares that such
streets, avenues, alleys and pas-
sageways as located, are not nec-
essary for any governmental pur-
pose as now existing, and such
changes and relocation of the
same are in the best interests of
said Town and its inhabitants.

Section 2. That in consideration
of the premises, and relocation
of said streets, alleys, avenues
and public passageways by the
present owners of the lots and
lands served by such streets, av-
enues, alleys and passageways,
it is determined, ordered and
declared that the following
streets, avenues, alleys and pas-
sageways in that part of Creed-
moor, formerly Amethyst, here-
inafter mentioned, be and the
same are hereby vacated and
closed:

- (a) All of High Avenue in
Creedmoor;
- (b) All of Prospect Avenue
in Creedmoor;
- (c) Wall Street from the west
line of Creedmoor to the
West line of the alley in
Block 33, Creedmoor;
- (d) North Second Street from
the West line of Creedmoor
to the West side line of
Chestnut Avenue, in Creed-

Block 33, Creedmoor;

(d) North Second Street from the West line of Creedmoor to the West side line of Chestnut Avenue, in Creedmoor;

(e) North Third Street from the West line of Creedmoor to the West side line of Chestnut Avenue, in Creedmoor;

(f) All alleys in Blocks 7, 8, 11, 12, 28 and 32 in Creedmoor, and that part of the alley in Block 27, in Creedmoor, lying North of the North lines of Lots 6 and 25.

Section 3. That the fee title to the land included in said streets, avenues, alleys and passageways so vacated, and all the right, title and interest of the State of Colorado, and the City of Creede, a Town, or the inhabitants thereof, shall be deemed and taken to vest in the proprietors of the lots and blocks abutting upon said streets, avenues, alleys and passageways so vacated and closed, as provided by law, each abutting owner taking to the center of such street, avenue, alley or passageway abutting his, her or its lots.

Section 4. The Board of Trustees of the City of Creede, a Town, hereby find and determine that a shortage of adequate housing and sites exists in said Town, which requires the immediate relocation of the streets, avenues, alleys and passageways in said area to permit replatting of said area by the owner thereof; and finds and declares that an emergency exists; and that it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Creede that this ordinance be passed and that it shall become effective five days after its passage and publication.

Introduced, read in full, passed, adopted and approved, and ordered published in The Del Norte Prospector and Creede Candle, a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Creede, at a meeting of the Board of Trustees of the City of Creede, held on the 12th day of February, A. D. 1968.
