

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE WATER SYSTEM BUILT IN
THAT PORTION OF CREEDE, KNOWN AS AMETHYST HEIGHTS SUBDIVISION
AND ACCEPTING SUCH WATER SYSTEM AS PART OF THE WATER SYSTEM
OF THE CITY OF CREEDE, A TOWN.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the City of Creede, a Town,
Mineral County, Colorado;

WHEREAS Elizabeth J. McClure has heretofore made, executed
and delivered to the City of Creede, a Town, her quit-claim deed conveying
to the City of Creede, all her right, title and interest in and to the
public domestic water system formerly owned by the said Elizabeth J. Mc-
Clure, which deed conveyed her title and interest in such water system;
and whereas such transfer and conveyance was made without charge to the
City of Creede, a Town;

AND WHEREAS such water system is presently laid down in the
streets and public ways of Amythest Heights Subdivision to the City of
Creede; and whereas it is for the use of the general public in such
area;

AND WHEREAS the Board of Trustees finds that it is to the best
interest of the City of Creede and the inhabitants thereof to accept such
water system and the conveyance thereof.

NOW THEREFORE the City of Creede, a Town, does hereby accept
such conveyance and by this ordinance incorporates such water system in
such Subdivision as a part of its municipal water system.

THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES of the City of Creede, a Town, further
finds and declares that an emergency exists and that it is necessary that
such water system become a part of the municipal water system at once; and
that therefore it is necessary for the immediate preservation and the public
peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Creede that this
Ordinance be passed; and that the same shall become effective ten days
after its passage and publication.

RESOLUTION CONCERNING THE PUBLICATION
OF ORDINANCE NO. 175, BY POSTING
