

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING FILING OF  
APPLICATION WITH THE FEDERAL  
WATER QUALITY ASSOCIATION,  
UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, FOR  
GRANT UNDER THE WATER POLLUTION  
CONTROL ACT, (33 U.S.C. 466 et seq.)

WHEREAS, under the terms of the Water Pollution Control Act (33 U.S.C. 466 et seq.), United States of America has authorized the making of grants to authorized applicants to aid in the construction of specific public projects, now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Creede, a Town, in Mineral County, Colorado, by and through its Board of Trustees,

1. That James Basham, Mayor, is hereby authorized to execute and file an application on behalf of the City of Creede, with the United States Government for a grant of aid in the construction of Sewage Treatment and Outfall Sewer, in conjunction with an entire water and sewage project, and he is hereby authorized and directed to furnish such information as the Federal Water Quality Administration may reasonably request in connection with such application and sign all necessary documents and receive payment.
