

ORDINANCE NO. 184

ANNUAL LEVY AND APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE CITY OF CREEDE,  
AN INCORPORATED TOWN, IN THE COUNTY OF MINERSL AND STATE OF COLORADO:

Section 1. That, in accordance with the Annual Mill Levy Resolution heretofore adopted, passed and approved by said Board of Trustees, for the purposes of raising revenue for general purposes, and for the creation of a sinking fund to pay indebtedness of said City, created or to be created, and for other contingencies that may arise, there be and is hereby levied and assessed upon, and there shall be collected on and from each dollar of the assessed valuation of all taxable real and personal property within the corporate limits of said City of Creede, as shown by the 1970 assessment rolls in the office of the County Assessor of Mineral County Colorado, a tax of Nineteen mills (19.00), for the use of the general corporate purposes, water works, sewage works and firemens pension fund of Said City of Creede, during the ensuing fiscal year. (19.00).

Section 2. That, out of the revenues of said City of Creede, an incorporated Town, in the County of Mineral and State of Colorado, from whatever source derived, there be and is hereby appropriated, for the purposes of derafying the necessary expenses and liabilities of the said CITY OF CREEDE, an incorporated Town, for the next ensuing year, for the following objects and purposes, the following sums, to-wit:

Firemens Pension	-0-
Water Works	22,140.95
