

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE CREEDE WATER DEPARTMENT; ESTABLISHING CHARGES, PENALTIES FOR NON-PAYMENT; SIZES OF WATER TAPS; DUTIES OF TOWN CLERK.

Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the City of Creede, a Town, State of Colorado, at a special meeting on September 10, A.D. 1971:

9-1-1 Creation of Water Department There is hereby created and established a water department of the Town of Creede for the purpose of the management, maintenance, care and operation of the water works of the Town.

9-1-2 Commissioner; Powers The Town Water Commissioner shall have the immediate control and management of all things pertaining to the Town water works system, and he shall perform all acts that may be necessary for the prudent, efficient, and economical management and protection of said water works, subject to the approval and confirmation of the Board of Trustees. The Board shall have the power to prescribe such other and further rates, rules and regulations as it may deem necessary.

9-1-3 Receipts and Deposits The Town Clerk shall keep a correct account of all receipts, make out all bills for water rents and materials furnished to consumers, collect the same, and deposit the proceeds so collected with the Town Treasurer as the credit of the water works fund of the Town, and in accordance with the direction of the Board.

9-1-4 Inspections Whenever in the judgment of the Water Commissioner he deems it necessary, he may inspect the premises or buildings of any water consumer for the purpose of examining the condition of all pipes, motors, meters and water fixtures, or the manner in which the water is used. He shall be vigilant to protect and remedy all abuses, whether from waste or other improper use of water.

9-1-5 Application for Water Application for the use of water shall be made to the Town Clerk by the owner or agent of the property to be benefited, designating the location of the property and stating the purpose for which the water may be required.

9-1-6 Tapping Charge Upon the application for a new tap and service connection by any consumer within the corporate limits of the Town, the applicant shall pay to the Town Clerk the sum of twenty (\$20.00) dollars to cover the cost of the corporation cock, fittings, installation of the tap, and the necessary pipe from the main to the curb box. The tap shall be installed by the Town. All necessary
