AN ORDINANCE CONCERNED WITH REPEAL OF 10-6-4, AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING MINORS PROHIBITED IN TAVERNS AND FURTHER CONCERNED WITH THE ENACTMENT OF AN ORDINANCE CONCERNED WITH OFFENSES RELATING TO CHILDREN AND PROHIBITING CHILDREN FROM TAVERNS; EXCEPTION, SIGNS TO BE POSTED.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the City of Creede, a Town in Mineral County, Colorado:

Section 1: 10-6-4 of Section 6, offenses relating to minors, and more specifically concerning minors prohibited in taverns; exceptions, signs to be posted be and the same hereby is repealed in its entirety.

Section 2: It shall be unlawful for any person who is the proprietor or keeper of the tavern to knowingly permit any child under the age of 18 years to frequent or be in or about such place unless accompanied by a parent or guardian.

Section 3: It shall be unlawful for any person who is the proprietor or keeper of a tavern for sale of 3.2 beer to knowingly permit any child under the age of 16 years to frequent or be in or about such place unless accompanied by a parent or guardian.

Section 4: It shall be the duty of any person who is the proprietor or keeper of a tavern to post conspicuously in his place of business the following sign: "CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF 16 YEARS NOT ALLOWED HERE UNLESS ACCOMPANIED BY PARENT OR GUARDIAN." It shall be the duty of the proprietor of a tavern for sale of 3.2 beer to post the following sign: "CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF 16 YEARS NOT ALLOWED HERE UNLESS ACCOMPANIED BY PARENT OR GUARDIAN." Failure to so post such signs shall constitute an unlawful act.

Section 5: The Board of Trustees of the City of Creede hereby determines that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety and shall be
