

ORDINANCE NO. 123

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL AND AMEND 9-2-16 OF ORDINANCE NO. 183, CONCERNED WITH RATES AND CHARGES FOR USE OF SEWERS IN THE TOWN OF CREEDE AND TO RAISE SAID SEWER RATES TO CONSUMERS.

WHEREAS, because it has been found and deemed necessary to increase rates for furnishing of sewer and sewer services in the Town of Creede to cover increased maintenance, service and other costs:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE CITY OF CREEDE, A TOWN IN MINERAL COUNTY, COLORADO:

Section 1: 9-2-16 of Ordinance No. 183 of the Town of Creede, County of Mineral, State of Colorado, is hereby repealed and re-enacted to read as follows, to-wit:

9-2-16 Rates and Charges for Use of Sewers There is hereby levied and charged on each lot, parcel of land and premises served by or having sewer connections with the sanitary sewer system of the Town or otherwise discharging sanitary sewage, industrial wastes, water or other liquids either directly or indirectly into the Town sanitary sewer system a sewer service charge or rental which shall be payable as and in an amount determinable as follows:

Single family dwelling on a single sewer connection.....	\$4.50
Duplexes, double houses, or other buildings containing two family dwelling units on a single sewer connection; each family dwelling unit.....	\$4.50
Apartments, apartment courts or other building containing three or more family dwelling units on a single sewer connection; each family dwelling unit.....	\$3.75
Hotels, motels, auto courts or trailer courts on a single sewer connection; each room, rental unit or trailer space.....	\$2.25
Churches and Lodges on a single sewer connection..	\$5.50
Drugstores with soda fountain on a single sewer connection.....	\$10.00
Drugstores without soda fountain on a single sewer connection.....	\$7.00
Schools on a single sewer connection.....	\$16.50
Barbershops and beauty parlors (including beauty parlors operated in family dwellings); for the first chair.....	\$5.25
for each additional chair.....	\$2.00
Clinics, medical offices and dental offices on a single sewer connection; for each practicing doctor or dentist.....	\$5.25

Hospitals, sanitariums and nursing homes on a single sewer connection; for each bed.....	\$1.50
Restaurants, bars, lounges and beer parlors on a single sewer connection:	
With a seating capacity of less than twenty.....	\$10.50
With a seating capacity of more than twenty and less than forty.....	\$16.50
With a seating capacity of more than forty.....	\$26.00
Pool halls and recreation parlors on a single sewer connection.....	\$10.50
Garages and filling stations without wash racks, laundries and cream stations on a single sewer connection.....	\$10.50
Garages and filling stations with wash racks on a single sewer connection.....	\$16.50
Creameries and automatic car washers on a single sewer connection.....	\$19.50
All other business and commercial establishments on a single sewer connection.....	10.50 \$6.25
plus for each toilet or lavatory over one.....	\$1.50
Manufacturing or industrial plant which discharges industrial wastes into the sewer on a single sewer connection as by special agreement with a minimum charge of.....	\$75.00

All out-of-town connections shall be established at the rate of 2.0 times the existing in-town rate and shall be subject to approval by the Town Board.

Over and above the rates and charges established by this section there may be established, in special instances and by special agreement between the town and the owner of any premises served by the Town sewer system, such additional charges for commercial or industrial wastes of unusual strength or composition that are accepted by the Town for treatment as may be determined to be fair and equitable. Each such special agreement and charges established therefor shall not become effective until ratified by resolution passed by the Board of Trustees.

Nothing in this section shall be construed to prevent any special agreement or arrangement between the Town and other municipalities sanitation districts, additions and development areas outside the Town concerning sewerage facilities, which shall not become effective until ratified by resolution passed by the Board of Trustees; provided, that the rates established by such agreement or arrangement shall not be less than one and one-half (1 1/2) times the rate for the same class of users within the Town.

Section 2: The above and foregoing repeal and re-enactment of said section concerned with rates and charges for use of sewers in the Town of Creede shall be effective and in full force and effect commencing on and after February 1, 1975.
