

ORDINANCE NO. 206

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CERTAIN PROVISION OF SECTION 2, CHAPTER XI, ANIMALS AND FOWL, AND MORE PARTICULARLY, AMENDING FEES AND TIME LIMITS

BE IT ORDAINED by The Board of Trustees of the City of Creede, Colorado, A Town, at a Regular Meeting held on the 3rd day of August, 1976:

Section 1 - REPEAL - The following provisions of Section 2, Chapter XI, Animals and Fowl, entitled "Dogs", are hereby repealed, to be reenacted with Amendments hereafter:

Section 2 - NEW PROVISIONS: The following provisions, bearing the same numerical designations as set forth above, are hereby adopted as a part of Section 2 of Chapter XI of the Code of the City of Creede, Colorado:

a. 11-2-3; Fees; The annual license fee for dogs within this town shall be Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for unspayed females and unneutered males and Three Dollars (\$3.00) for spayed females and neutered males.

b. 11-2-16; Notice to Owner or Keeper of Dogs; As soon as practicable after the date of impoundment, the Dog Catcher shall send by regular mail a written notice of such impoundment to the owner, possessor or keeper of such dog if the address of such person be known; if the owner, possessor, or keeper of such dog is not known or if his address cannot be determined, the Dog Catcher shall cause

to be posted in a conspicuous place in the town for three (3) consecutive days, a Notice of Impoundment. Whether the Notice herein provided be mailed or posted, it shall describe the dog, set forth the date of impoundment and set forth the location from which the dog was taken.


c. 11-2-18; Disposal of Dog whose Owner or Keeper cannot be located; If a Complaint has not been filed in Municipal Court because the Owner, possessor or keeper of an impounded dog is not known or cannot be located and such dog is not claimed within three (3) days from the date of impoundment, not counting the first day of impoundment, the dog may be disposed of in any humane manner prescribed by the dog catcher or by persons so authorized to do so by the Town Administrator.

d. 11-2-19; Redemption Fee; Any Owner, Possessor or Keeper of a Dog desiring to redeem such dog from the Pound shall pay the City the sum of Five Dollars (\$5.00) as an impoundment fee together with the sum of Two Dollars (\$2.00) for each day of impoundment for room and board and any and all license or Rabies inoculation fees provided for in this section.

Section 3 - SAFETY CLAUSE - Each and every provision of this Ordinance, together with the Original Chapter XI, is intended to be separate and severable from every other provision hereof and shall take affect regardless of the invalidity of any other part of this Ordinance or of the Original Chapter.
