

ORDINANCE NO. 210

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC IN SPECIFIC LOCATIONS UPON THE PUBLIC STREETS OF THE CITY OF CREEDE, COLORADO, A TOWN.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the City of Creede, Colorado, A Town:

SECTION 1: AUTHORITY - The authority for this Ordinance is Title 31 and Title 42 of the 1973 Colorado Revised Statutes conferring upon the City the authority to regulate the flow of traffic within the municipality.

SECTION 2: It is hereby determined upon the basis of traffic investigation that regulation of the flow of traffic at certain intersections is necessary for the public good and, in accordance therewith, there are hereby established the following control devices at the following locations, which shall be officially designated by the use of proper signs of types uniform throughout the State of Colorado:

A. At the intersection of Third Street and Lomas, traffic proceeding East on Third Street shall be compelled to Stop and thereafter yield to oncoming traffic in accordance with the model traffic code. Such Stop sign shall be placed on the South shoulder of Third Street facing West, to control such East bound traffic.

B. At the intersection of Third Street and Rio Grande Avenue, traffic proceeding North on Rio Grande Avenue shall be compelled to Stop and thereafter yield to oncoming traffic in accordance with the model traffic code. Such Stop sign shall be placed on the East side of Rio Grande Avenue facing South to control such North bound traffic.

C. At the intersection of Third Street and Rio Grande Avenue, traffic proceeding West on Third Street shall be compelled to yield to on-

coming traffic in accordance with the model traffic code. Such Yield Sign shall be placed on the North shoulder of Third Street facing East to control such West bound traffic.

D. At the intersection of Rio Grande Avenue and Fifth Street, traffic proceeding South shall be compelled to stop and thereafter yield to oncoming traffic in accordance with the model traffic code. Such Stop sign shall be placed on the West side of Rio Grande Avenue facing North to control such South bound traffic.


SECTION 3. The penalties for violation of this Ordinance shall be as provided in the Model Traffic Code and other Ordinances previously enacted by the City of Creede.
