AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL AND AMEND 9-1-11 of ORDINANCE NO. 184, CONCERNED WITH WATER RATES IN THE TOWN OF CREEDE, REPEALING ORDINANCES NO. 194 AND 195, BEING A PRECEEDING INCREASE IN SUCH RATES AND TO RAISE SAID WATER RATES TO CONSUMERS.

WHEREAS, because it has been found and deemed necessary to increase rates for furnishing of water in the Town of Creede to cover increased costs of maintenance, service and similar costs:

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the City of Creede, Colorado, A Town, in Mineral County, Colorado:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 194 and 195 be and the same are hereby repealed, which ordinances were established for the sole purpose of establishing water rates as of the date of such ordinances and which rates are no longer feasible.

SECTION 2. 9-1-11 of Ordinance No. 184 of the Town of Creede, County of Mineral, State of Colorado is hereby repealed and re-enacted to read as follows, to-wit:

9-1-11 Water Rates: All water sold by the Town of Creede shall be sold at the following rates:

	<u>RATE PER MONTH</u>
All Single Family Residences	\$ 8.25
Hotels and Motels	\$ 11.50
Trailer Courts and Multi-unit apartments	\$ 8.25 per unit or trailer
All small businesses which use water in the business	\$ 11.50

Water rates for persons, entities or buildings not specifically covered herein shall be set by the Board of Trustees of the City of Creede, Colorado, A Town in conformity with the intent of the foregoing rates.

SECTION 3. The above and foregoing repeal and re-enactment of said Section concerned with water rates shall be effective and in full force and effect commencing or after the 4<sup>th</sup> day of February, 1980.
