

ORDINANCE NO. 218

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF SECTION 2, CHAPTER XI, ANIMALS AND FOWL, AND MORE PARTICULARLY, AMENDING FEES

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the City of Creede, Colorado, A Town, at a Regular meeting held on the 5th day of June, 1980:

Section 1 - REPEAL - The following provision of Section 2, Chapter XI, Animals and Fowl, entitled "Dogs", is hereby repealed, to be reenacted with Amendments hereafter:

11-2-3 Fees

Section 2 - NEW PROVISION: The following provision bearing the same numerical designations as set forth above, is hereby adopted as a part of Section 2 of Chapter XI of the Code of the City of Creede, Colorado:

a. 11-2-3; Fees; The annual license fee for dogs within this town shall be Five Dollars (\$5.00) per dog, annually, regardless of sex.

Section 3 - SAFETY CLAUSE - Each and every provision of this Ordinance, together with the Original Chapter XI, is intended to be separate and severable from every other provision hereof and shall take affect regardless of the invalidity of any other part of this Ordinance or of the Original Chapter.
