

ORDINANCE NO. 224

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL AND AMEND 9-1-11 OF ORDINANCE NO. 184, CONCERNED WITH WATER RATES IN THE TOWN OF CREEDE, REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 216, BEING A PRECEEDING INCREASE IN SUCH RATES AND TO RAISE SAID WATER RATES TO CONSUMER.

WHEREAS, because it has been found and deemed necessary to increase rates for furnishing of water in the Town of Creede to cover increased costs of maintenance, service and similar costs:

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the City of Creede, Colorado, A Town, in Mineral County, Colorado:

SECTION I: Ordinance No. 216 be and the same is hereby repealed, which ordinance was established for the sole purpose of establishing water rates as of the date of such ordinance and which rates are no longer feasible.

SECTION II: 9-1-11 of Ordinance No. 184 of the Town of Creede, County of Mineral, State of Colorado, is hereby repealed and re-enacted to read as follows, to-wit:

9-1--11 WATER RULES: All water sold by the Town of Creede shall be sold at the following rates:

	Rates per Month
All single family residences	9.75
Hotels and Motels & Schools	13.00
Trailer Courts and Multi-unit apartments (per unit or trailer)	9.75
All small businesses which use water in the business	13.00
Large business	26.00
Industrial	75.00

Water rates for persons, entities or buildings not specifically covered herein shall be set by the Board of Trustees of the City of Creede, Colorado, A Town in conformity with the intent of the foregoing rates.

SECTION III: The above and foregoing repeal and re-enactment of said Section concerned with water rates shall be effective on or after the 1st day of January, 1981.
