

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL AND AMEND 9-2-6 OF ORDINANCE NO. 183, WHICH ORDINANCE ESTABLISHED THE TAPPING FEE WITH RESPECT TO SEWER CONNECTIONS TO THE PUBLIC SANITARY SEWER OF THE CITY OF CREEDE.

WHEREAS, it has been found and deemed necessary to increase the sewer tap fee for tapping private sewer lines into the sanitary sewer system of the City of Creede and further, to clarify the effective date hereof and further to clarify the application of such fees:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE CITY OF CREEDE, COLORADO, A TOWN, IN MINERAL COUNTY, COLORADO:

SECTION I: Section 9-2-6 of Ordinance #183 be and the same is hereby repealed and from and after the effective date of this ordinance and the cancellation of the moritorium now in effect on sewer connections, the effective sewer rates for the Town of Creede shall be in accordance with this ordinance.

SECTION II: Section 9-2-6 of Ordinance #183 of the Town of Creede is hereby repealed and reenacted to read as follows to-wit:

9-2-6(A): At the time of filing the application, the applicant shall pay a tapping fee of \$400.00 for the connection to the sewer of any property within the corporate limits, ~~and the sum of~~ ~~dollars for the connection to the sewer of any property located outside of the corporate limits.~~

9-2-6(B): Such fee shall cover only the privilege to connect to the public sanitary sewer system of the City of Creede and the final connection of the private line to the public sanitary sewer. Such fee shall not cover any other work whatsoever, whether material, equipment, or labor.

SECTION III: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect except as set forth in Section I hereof, 30 days after publication.


