ORDINANCE NO. 26.

An ordinance granting the Denver & Rio Grande Railroad company the use of a portion of Rio Grande street in South Creede:

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Creede:

Section 1. That the Denver and Rio Grande Railroad company be and is hereby authorized to use for railroad purposes that portion of Rio Grande street in South Creede, on the easterly side of and adjoining the right of way of the said Denver and Rio Grande Railroad company and north of Block Four in said South Creede more particularly described as follows: Extending in a southerly direction from the northerly line or boundary of South Creede to, with in Seventy five (75) feet of Block Four in South Creede and extending in an easterly direction from said right of way to within Eighty five (85) feet of the east line of the said San Luis Avenue for platform, track and wagon approach purposes, provided that no building or buildings shall be constructed or maintained thereon.

Section 2. That Ordinance No. twenty five (25) passed on the 7th day of November, 1892, be and the same is hereby repealed.

Adopted and passed this 5th day of December, 1892.
