

ORDINANCE 262

CONTINGENCY ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL SUMS OF MONEY TO DEFRAID EXPENSES IN EXCESS OF AMOUNTS BUDGETED FOR THE CITY OF CREEDE, A COLORADO TOWN.

WHEREAS, the operation of the trash fund is necessary to protect the public health, safety and welfare, and increased costs are being incurred due to repair costs, and

WHEREAS, this contingency could not have been reasonably foreseen at the time of the adoption of the budget, and

WHEREAS, money is available in the same fund in the form of unappropriated or unrestricted surpluses to meet this contingency.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the City of Creede, a Colorado Town;

That the 1986 appropriation for the Trash Fund is hereby increased from \$19,244 to \$21,300 including the contingency.
