

ORDINANCE 263

CONTINGENCY ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL SUMS OF MONEY TO DEFRAID EXPENSES IN EXCESS OF AMOUNTS BUDGETED FOR THE CITY OF CREEDE, A COLORADO TOWN.

WHEREAS, the completion of the City sidewalk project was necessary to protect the public health, safety and welfare, and increased costs were experienced, and

WHEREAS, this contingency could not have been reasonably foreseen at the time of the adoption of the budget, and


WHEREAS, money will be transferred from the General Fund, where it is not needed or restricted at this time, to the Capital Improvement Fund where the contingency has arisen.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the City of Creede, a Colorado Town;

Section 1. That the 1986 appropriation for the General Fund is hereby increased from \$146,810 to \$184,043.

Section 2. That the sum of \$37,233 is hereby transferred from unappropriated and unrestricted surpluses in the General Fund to the Capital Improvement Fund.
