

ORDINANCE # 272

ORDINANCE TO SET MILL LEVY

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING GENERAL PROPERTY TAXES FOR THE YEAR 1989, TO HELP DEFRAY THE COSTS OF GOVERNMENT FOR THE CITY OF CREEDE, A COLORADO TOWN, FOR THE 1990 BUDGET YEAR.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the City of Creede, a Town, have adopted the annual budget in accordance with the Local Government Budget law, on November 6, 1989, and

WHEREAS, the amount of money necessary to balance the budget for general operating expense is \$23,225, and


WHEREAS, the 1989 valuation for assessment for the City of Creede, as certified by the County Assessor is \$2,111,360.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE CITY OF CREEDE, A COLORADO TOWN:


Section 1. That for the purpose of meeting all general operating expenses of the City of Creede, a Town, during the 1990 budget year, there is hereby levied a tax of 11.000 mills upon each dollar of the total valuation for assessment of all taxable property within the City of Creede, for the year 1989.

Section 2. That the City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to immediately certify to the County Commissioners of Mineral County, Colorado, the mill levy for the City of Creede, as hereinabove determined and set.
