ORDINANCE FOR SUPPLEMENTARY BUDGET
AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL SUMS OR MONEY TO DEFRAID
EXPENSES IN EXCESS OF AMOUNTS BUDGETED FOR THE CITY OF
CREEDE, COLORADO FOR THE 1990 BUDGET YEAR.


WHEREAS, the City of Creede received unanticipated
revenue not assured at the time of the adoption of the 1990
budget.

WHEREAS, the money received came from the United States
Government in the form of grant funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of
Trustees of the City of Creede a Colorado town, that the 1990
appropriation for the City General Fund is hereby increased
from \$115,064 to \$129,064 in order to spend the Forest
Service Grant funds on the completion of a feasibility study
for the establishment of a tourist train from South Fork to
Creede.

ADOPTED by unanimous vote this 3rd day of December, 1990.
