

Resolution No. 2011-08

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF CREEDE, A COLORADO TOWN, AS THE LOCAL LIQUOR LICENSING AUTHORITY TO ISSUE SPECIAL EVENT LIQUOR PERMITS TO QUALIFIED ENTITIES WITHOUT PRIOR NOTIFICATION OR APPROVAL FROM THE STATE LICENSING AUTHORITY PURSUANT TO SENATE BILL 11-066

WHEREAS, the Colorado legislature recently passed and the Governor signed into law Senate Bill 11-066, entitled "An Act Concerning The Issuance of Special Event Permits to Serve Alcohol Beverages"; and

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 11-066 became effective August 10, 2011; and

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 11-066 authorizes a local licensing authority to elect not to notify the state licensing authority to obtain the state licensing authority's approval or disapproval for a special event permit; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority granted by Senate Bill 11-066, the Creede Board of Trustees, sitting as the Liquor Licensing Authority, finds and determines that it should elect not to notify the state licensing authority to obtain the state licensing authority's approval or disapproval for a special event permit; and

WHEREAS, the Colorado Code of Regulations 47-1018(C) requires that a Special Events Permit application to be submitted not less than thirty days prior to the date of the special event, yet it may be possible to process such an application in less than thirty days under certain circumstances; and

WHEREAS, Colorado Code of Regulations 47-1018(G) authorizes the state or local licensing authority to waive any time limits contained in the regulation for good cause shown;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Creede, Colorado:
Section 1. The Creede Board of Trustees, in its capacity as the Local Licensing Authority, hereby elects not to notify the State Licensing Authority to obtain its approval or disapproval of an application for a Special Event Permit pursuant to Section 12-48-107 (5), C.R.S.

Section 2. Special Event Permit applications may be accepted less than thirty days prior to the event date at the discretion of the Town Clerk and when accompanied by a rush processing fee of \$25.00.

Section 3. When exercising her administrative duties with respect to an application for a special event permit, the Town Clerk shall comply with the requirements of the Special Events Code, and shall perform all action required by such statute.

Section 4. This resolution shall become effective upon its adoption.
