RESOLUTION NO. 2022-03**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF CREEDE, CO EXPRESSING SUPPORT FOR AN APPLICATION TO THE COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION'S REVITALIZING MAIN STREET GRANT PROGRAM REQUESTING \$2,000,000, TO BE MATCHED WITH \$500,000 IN LOCAL FUNDING, FOR THE PURPOSE OF COMPLETING A MAIN STREET REVITALIZATION PROJECT MORE OR LESS BETWEEN THE INTERSECTION OF MAIN STREET AND LOMA AVENUE IN THE NORTH AND THE INTERSECTION OF MAIN STREET AND SEVENTH STREET TO THE SOUTH IN ORDER TO INCREASE PEDESTRIAN SAFETY AND MOBILITY AND ENHANCE THE STREETScape**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees for the City of Creede, CO, is desirous of making improvements to the Main Street corridor that improve pedestrian safety and mobility through the replacement of sidewalks, the addition of ADA compliant intersections, the relocation of utilities, drainage improvements and the installation of attractive lighting and street furniture as well as public street art ; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees would like to leverage local funding in an amount not to exceed \$500,000 in order to secure a grant from the Colorado Department of Transportation in the amount of \$2,000,000;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Trustees of the City of Creede, Mineral County, Colorado, that:

**Section 1.** The Board of Trustees hereby authorizes the Town Manager to prepare and submit a grant application to the Colorado Department of Transportation requesting \$2,000,000 for the purpose of making improvements to Main Street and adjoining streets that increase pedestrian safety and mobility and enhance the streetscape, and further commit to providing local funding in an amount not to exceed \$500,000 for the purpose of securing said grant funds.

**Section 2. Effective Date.** This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.

**Section 3. Repealer.** All resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed, provided that such repealer shall not repeal the repealer clauses of such resolution nor revive any resolution thereby.

**Section 4. Certification.** The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this resolution and make not less than one copy of the adopted resolution available for inspection by the public during regular business hours.
