RESOLUTION NO. 2022-12**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF CREEDE, COLORADO, EXERCISING ITS  
OPTION TO “OPT-OUT” OF RECEIVING ITS DIRECT SHARE OF THE  
OPIOID SETTLEMENT FUNDS**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees, by the adoption of Resolution No. 2021-21 approved the Colorado Opioid Litigation Memorandum of Understanding and joined the City of Creede into the State Settlement Agreements; and

**WHEREAS**, the local share of the opioid settlement funds for the City of Creede is estimated to be \$37.43 for the first year and the total over 18 years is estimated to be \$332.91; and

**WHEREAS**, if Creede retained the funds, it would be obligated to account for the funds received and to report annually to the Colorado Opioid Abatement Council (COAC) how the funds were expended;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Trustees of the City of Creede, Mineral County, Colorado, that:

**Section 1.** City of Creede hereby chooses to “opt-out” of receiving its direct share of the opioid settlement funds.

**Section 2. Effective Date.** This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.

**Section 3. Repealer.** All resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed, provided that such repealer shall not repeal the repealer clauses of such resolution nor revive any resolution thereby.


**Section 4. Certification.** The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this resolution and make not less than one copy of the adopted resolution available for inspection by the public during regular business hours.
