RESOLUTION NO. 22-11**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF CREEDE, COLORADO, ADOPTING A
FLOOD MANAGEMENT INFRASTRUTURE PLAN FOR THE CITY OF
CREEDE**

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees, is desirous of making the Town's infrastructure resilient to damage from flooding; and

WHEREAS, the Headwaters Alliance has developed the "City of Creede Flood Mitigation Infrastructure Plan" as a guiding policy document for the Town that will assist with the prioritization and of flood mitigation infrastructure projects along the Willow Creek and the procurement of grant funding for project implementation;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of the City of Creede, Mineral County, Colorado, that:

Section 1. **Adoption.** The *City of Creede Flood Mitigation Infrastructure Plan* is adopted as the Town's flood risk mitigation plan.

Section 2. **Effective Date.** This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.

Section 3. **Repealer.** All resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed, provided that such repealer shall not repeal the repealer clauses of such resolution nor revive any resolution thereby.

Section 4. **Certification.** The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this resolution and make not less than one copy of the adopted resolution available for inspection by the public during regular business hours.
