RESOLUTION NO. 2022-17**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE CITY OF CREEDE  
EXPRESSING SUPPORT FOR A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE DOLA REDI  
PROGRAM REQUESTING \$150K TO BE USED FOR DESIGN FEES ASSOCIATED  
WITH THE CREEDE ARTS CENTER**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees is desirous of developing a vacant tract of land south of the Kentucky Belle parking lot; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees has spoken with Stephen Quiller about facilitating the construction of a community arts center on said tract of land; and

**WHEREAS**, Stephen Quiller has raised enough matching funds to supply the required local match equal to the amount requested in the DOLA REDI grant application; and

**WHEREAS**, the maximum request amount in the DOLA REDI grant program is \$150,000; and

**WHEREAS**, the requested funds will be used to pay a portion of the fees associated with the design of the arts center; and

**WHEREAS**, the City will serve as a pass-through for the funding and no City funds will be required in relation to the request;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Trustees of the City of Creede, Mineral County, Colorado, that:

Section 1. The Board hereby authorizes the Town Manager to apply for the DOLA REDI grant as outlined in this resolution.

Section 2. **Effective Date.** This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.

Section 3. **Repealer.** All resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed, provided that such repealer shall not repeal the repealer clauses of such resolution nor revive any resolution thereby.

Section 4. **Certification.** The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this resolution and make not less than one copy of the adopted resolution available for inspection by the public during regular business hours.
