RESOLUTION NO. 2022-19**

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE CITY OF CREEDE EXPRESSING SUPPORT FOR THREE GRANT APPLICATIONS TO FEMA FOR A COMBINED TOTAL OF \$5,682,391 IN FUNDING TO IMPLEMENT THE CITY'S COMPREHENSIVE FLOOD HAZARD MITIGATION INFRASTRUCTURE PLAN AND COMMITTING TO COMBINED PROJECT FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$389,877 FROM THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees is desirous of implementing the City's Comprehensive Flood Hazard Mitigation Infrastructure Plan that it adopted by approval of Resolution # 2022-11 on 04/12/22; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees expresses support for three grant applications to FEMA for a combined total of \$5,682,391 in funding to implement a comprehensive \$6,313,768 flood hazard mitigation project in accordance with Exhibit A attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees agrees to commit a combined total of \$389,877 in City Capital Improvement Fund funds for all three projects representing approximately 6% of the combined project total and approximately 62% of the required 10% local match requirement in accordance with Exhibit A attached hereto;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees for the City of Creede, CO that the Town Manager is hereby authorized to submit three separate funding requests to FEMA as outlined in Exhibit A attached hereto;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Board of Trustees agrees to commit to a combined total of \$389,877 in Capital Improvement Fund funds in accordance with the cost breakdown outlined in Exhibit A attached hereto and to the combined lesser total should one or more of the three funding requests be rejected by FEMA.

Section 1. Effective Date. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.

Section 2. Repealer. All resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed, provided that such repealer shall not repeal the repealer clauses of such resolution nor revive any resolution thereby.

Section 3. Certification. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this resolution and make not less than one copy of the adopted resolution available for inspection by the public during regular business hours.
