

**CITY OF CREEDE, COLORADO
ORDINANCE NO. 439**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CREEDE, COLORADO AMENDING CHAPTER
TWO, ARTICLE 2, SECTIONS 2-2-10 AND 2-2-80 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF
THE CITY OF CREEDE, COLORADO**

WHEREAS, on April 5, 2022, at the regular municipal election and pursuant to C.R.S. §31-4-301.5, the electors of the City of Creede reduced the number of Trustees from six to four.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE CITY OF CREEDE, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. "CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE 2, SECTION 2-2-10(a) of the Municipal Code of the City of Creede, Colorado is amended to read as follows:

(a) Authority. The Board of Trustees shall consist of one (1) Mayor and four (4) Trustees. The Board of Trustees shall constitute the legislative body of the City; shall have the power and authority, except as otherwise provided by statute, to exercise all power conferred upon or possessed by the City; and shall have the power and authority to adopt such laws, ordinances and resolutions as it shall deem proper in the exercise thereof. The Board of Trustees is given specific authority and power to appoint such other officers, prescribe their duties and fix their compensation, as it may deem necessary for the good government of the City.

Section 2. "CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE 2, SECTION 2-2-80(a) of the Municipal Code of the City of Creede, Colorado is amended to read as follows:

(a) The Mayor may convene a special meeting of the Board of Trustees at any time. In addition, any three (3) Trustees may call a special meeting of the Board of Trustees. Whenever a special meeting is called, a notice in writing shall be served upon each member of the Board of Trustees, either in person or by notice left at his or her usual place of residence, stating the date and hour of the meeting and the purpose for which such meeting is called. No business shall be transacted at such meeting, except as is stated in the notice. The City Clerk shall give such notice, at least forty-eight (48) hours in advance of the special meeting.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be published and become effective as provided by law.

Section 4. Severability. If any part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections of the ordinance. The Town Board hereby declares that it would have passed the ordinance including each part, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that one or more parts, sections, subsections, sentence, clauses or phrases are declared invalid.

Section 5. Repealer. All ordinances or resolutions and motions of the Board of Trustees of the City of Creede or parts thereof, in conflict with this ordinance are to the extent of such

conflict hereby superseded and repealed, provided that such repealer shall not repeal the repealer clauses of such ordinance, resolution or motion, nor revive any ordinance, resolution or motion thereby.


